WEAVE is the primary provider of crisis intervention services for survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault in Sacramento County. Through a multidisciplinary effort with Sacramento County, law enforcement, the Commercially Sexually Exploited Children Court, Child Protective Services, and the District Attorney's Office, WEAVE also provides 24/7 response, outreach and services for victims of sex trafficking.

Runnin' for Rhett is a non-profit organization that was founded on December 7th, 2007 by a grass roots group of family and friends that love Rhett Seevers. Our mission is to inspire people to Move into Life. We do this through our vision of nurturing healthy communities through fitness and nutrition.
